NOTIFICATION OF RELOCATING OCCUPIED GRAVES CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA PROJECT NO. COF1516383

Hurricane Matthew, a major Category 4 event, entered the southern borders of North Carolina on October 4, 2016 and traveled north leaving in its path widespread torrential rainfall, hurricane force winds, record level tidal actions and record breaking flooding throughout the Central and Eastern North Carolina Counties.

During the incident period of October 4-24th, The City of Fayetteville experienced an increase in rainfall and high waters. The increase caused the portion of Cross Creek to rise and flow at unexpected levels. The increased flow of waters caused approximately 18 acres 380’ (L) x 55’ (D) x 40’ (W) of embankment to fall and wash away along the west side near Lamson Street.

The embankment repair will affect 121 pauper graves in Cross Creek Cemetery #3 located at 301 Lamson Street. The graves have no markers and range in date from 1978 to 1996.

The City of Fayetteville, North Carolina will engage a well-qualified, compassionate, licensed and certified Funeral Home to carry out the delicate work of disinterring the 121 impacted graves and re-intering them in another City-owned cemetery close by.
